The Board of School Trustees recognizes the importance and prevalence of fund-raising projects that require sales in or around school buildings, however the Board discourages door-to-door solicitation by students. Any such projects must be submitted to the school principal for approval prior to the start of the project. The Principal, upon approval, sends the request to the Superintendent for final approval. All projects must be submitted to the Principal prior to the start of the project. Fund-raisers may not be conducted to raise money to benefit a single individual or family. Fund-raisers that involve selling food or drinks on school property during the school day must comply with the district's Wellness policy (10000-42).
