
MISCELLANEOUS - USE OF SCHOOL BUSES FOR NON-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

1. School buses may be used for the following additional purposes:
 - a. To transport adults sixty-five years of age and older
 - b. To transport groups of handicapped individuals.
 - c. To transport church groups participating in a church affiliated and sponsored function.
 - d. To transport children enrolled in a day camp operated by the district.
 - e. To transport school children to and from youth league athletic activities, 4-H club activities, junior achievement activities, boy scouts, girl scouts, and campfire girls activities, and recreational activities approved and sponsored by any political sub-division, subject to restrictions placed in this code.
 - f. To transport the public during a local public event or celebration.
 - g. To be used in a local, state or national emergency.
 - h. Any other purpose deemed appropriate by the Board of School Trustees.
2. The Board of School Trustees will consider requests at a regular or specially called meeting. Should an emergency exist or should the request come with very little notice, the Superintendent may consider the request and inform the Board at a later time.
3. The cost of the bus(es) and driver(s) shall be paid by the requesting group or individual.
4. Any group using the bus(es) will name the District as an additional insured in their insurance policy.

5. WWS may provide drivers for any rented bus. In instances when WWS cannot or chooses not to provide qualified drivers, the group using the bus(es) shall furnish qualified drivers. The group using the bus(es) shall also be responsible for insuring the driver and holding WWS harmless for any and all use of a bus or buses.
